

Virtual Time Capsule

Visitors can explore Neon Museum, including Neon Boneyard and Evening Glow digitally.







The nonprofit Neon Museum offers a 360 Virtual Tour, allowing visitors to "move" freely throughout the Neon Boneyard.

Guests can explore the culture and learn about the history of Southern Nevada by exploring the glowing collection. The digital circuit highlights more than 130 hotspots around the yard enhanced by content from the museum's archival collection. Give them a quick click to reveal written descriptions, historical photos, or short videos like a

short Neon Museum Gallery Talk or documentary. For an illuminated experience, check out the Evening Glow experience, which gives guests a chance to take the tour at night when place is all lit up with the glowing signs from Vegas' iconic past.

Speaking of icons, the 82-foottall neon guitar that beckoned visitors to the Las Vegas Hard Rock Café for 27 years underwent 1,650 hours of refurbishing last year in preparation of its move to the Boneyard. Check out the 27-minute documentary Strings of Neon to witness the resurrection of one of the city's enduring landmarks. Another tour highlight: artworks from the 2019–20 exhibition of Lost Vegas: Tim Burton @ The Neon Museum. Witness the recent relamping of the Stardust letters on the virtual tour.

The tour is available for \$10 and allows indefinite access to the content on any device, including a computer, smartphone, or tablet.
